Member's equipment is to be left by the side of the courts. The Coach and his assistants can have access for their equipment during scheduled coaching sessions.</p> <p><b>During play</b> - Stay at least 2 metres away from other players &amp; don't shake hands or high five. For doubles, consider agreeing in advance which player takes the shot if a ball travels to the centre of the court.
